## Principal's Message

### **NAPLAN Results have arrived!**

There is much more to a school than just its NAPLAN results, but they do help us see how a school is doing compared to similar schools in the important areas of literacy and numeracy. This year's NAPLAN results have been released later than planned and amid growing concerns about the validity of the process due to the introduction of online testing. However, individual student reports have now been delivered to families. Some of the key 2018 NAPLAN results show:

**In Numeracy:** 36% of Year 5 students achieving the top 2 performance bands – an increase of 12% compared to 2017.

**In Reading:** 71% of Year 3 students achieving the top 2 performance bands - an increase of 18% compared to 2017

**School Level Growth:** The percentage of Sutton students whose growth is equal to or greater than expected growth compared with the growth of students in a statistically similar schools group (SSSG) is as follows in

- Numeracy : 58.3% - equal to SSSG
- Spelling: 56% - equal to SSSG
- Writing: 64% - compared to 61% for SSSG

When compared to the state average however, the performance of Sutton students is equal to or greater across all domains in both Year 3 and 5 cohorts.

NAPLAN is used to guide improvement in our school. Valuable data are used to assist forward planning, allocating support and resources and tracking the progress and achievements of individual students, as well as an entire group of students, over the course of their educational journey. Whole school data is to be made available to schools via a new online platform in 2018. Our staff will develop a detailed analysis of our school performance as part of our annual school evaluation process and inform next steps towards meeting our school goals 2020.

## DRAFT Masterplan

Our school will celebrate its 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2021. The school wishes to mark this anniversary with a revitalised school precinct. Over the past couple of years the school has been working with a small group of parents to develop a vision for the infrastructure of our growing school. The Draft Masterplan document reveals this vision. Note that the Draft Masterplan is a vision of what we would like to achieve at the school, not necessarily a picture of what the school will look like.

Through this Masterplan we seek to improve student's safety, have more flexible learning and play spaces and present a functional and beautiful school befitting our surrounding environment.

We will work towards achieving the following nine projects in 2 stages.

### *Stage 1*

- i. Construct a new multipurpose building and demolish the existing 'Afties' building
- ii. Improve parking and limit car access on school grounds and relocate bins
- iii. Landscape internal courtyard following removal of the existing 'Afties' building
- iv. Refurbish existing infants toilets and include outside access

### *Stage 2*

- i. Construct a new classroom
- ii. Refurbish existing heritage classroom to provide staffroom facilities
- iii. Refurbish the existing administration building to provide appropriate office space, storage and front of school facilities
- iv. Unify the appearance of the school through landscaping
- v. Install photovoltaic panels

## **Are you planning on going to the Murrumbateman Field Days? Sutton School needs your help!**

For the last five years Sutton Primary School P&C has been given the opportunity to run the Parcel Delivery Service at the Murrumbateman Field Days. This is a great fundraiser for our school with the potential to raise a lot of money. We are running it again this year and we need lots of volunteers. Field Days management have asked us to run two cars again this year which requires a considerable number of volunteers.

This will be a great opportunity to meet other parents and raise some funds for the school. We can make this year the best one yet. If you are not sure go on the field days website... It looks like another amazing year this year.

### **What is it?**

When Field Day Patrons purchase items from Stalls that they don't want to carry around all day, they phone our service. We send a ute to the stall, collect the item and take the item to one of our Pick-up Bases at two entrance gates. Later when the patron is ready to leave they drive their car to the entrance gate and pick up their item and pay a fee.

### **What will volunteers have to do?**
