Swimming Carnival Years 3 – 6 Term 1, Week 2 2023

Dear Parents.

On Thursday 2nd February 2023 all Primary children will be attending our annual Swimming Carnival.

Children in Year 2, who are <u>turning 8 in 2023 and is able to swim 50m</u>, are also eligible to attend the carnival. If your child is in Year 2 in 2023 and CANNOT swim 50m they are <u>not permitted</u> to attend. All primary aged students in Years 3 to 6 are expected to attend the carnival.

As this involves water activities, the school requires that you complete the attached survey for every child participating. Each child attending the carnival will be required to wear a wrist band signifying if they are not a confident or competent 25 metre swimmer as a result of Department guidelines for water excursions and activities.

There will be some time in the medium pool which will be held in the 10m pool during the day for those not swimming in a race.

The carnival will be held at Dickson Pool from 10am until 2.00pm. We will all travel by bus. Parents are invited to join us for the day. Pool entry for parents is free. Cost for entry to pool and the bus fare for all children is \$12.00. This is a compulsory sporting event.

The children will need to bring swimmers, towel, hat, sunscreen, recess and lunch. The kiosk at the pool will be open and times will be allocated for the children to use it.

We will need parental help in timekeeping to enable the day to run smoothly.

By granting permission for your child to attend this excursion, you are approving their participation in water play activities in a busy public water park, and swimming activities.

If there are any questions regarding the day, please do not hesitate to ring the school.
