

Reconciliation Walk 2023

This note is to confirm details and seek permission for your child to attend the Reconciliation Walk in Queanbeyan on Tuesday 30th May 2023.

Each year, National Reconciliation Week celebrates and builds on the respectful relationships shared by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and other Australians. National Reconciliation Week is 27th May to 3rd June and this year's theme is 'Be a Voice for Generations'.

When: Tuesday 30th May 2023

- Where: Students will travel by bus to Trinculo Place, Marj Christian Park where they will join other Queanbeyan schools. The approx. 1km walk will begin at Queen's Bridge on Monaro Street, finishing at the Reconciliation Gardens at Queanbeyan Park (corner of Campbell and Lowe streets).
- **Time:** 9:20 Departure for a 10:30am start. A cultural performance and flag raising ceremony will occur at the end of the walk. The event will finish by 12.00pm. Students will have an opportunity to have lunch prior to the buses departing. Buses will collect students from Queanbeyan Park at 12.30pm, to arrive back at Sutton Public School by 1:00pm.
- Supervision: Staff from Sutton Public School
- What to wear: Full Winter School Uniform please
- What to bring: A hat, drink bottle containing plenty of water, Crunch & Sip and a packed lunch. Students will eat Crunch & Sip on arrival and will enjoy lunch prior to returning to school.
